The building originally served as a county prison and pre-trial detention centre. The prison was closed in 2002.

The oldest part of Hotel Katajanokka dates back to 1837 and the main part to 1888.

Following extensive restoration work, a high-quality modern hotel opened its doors in May 2007. The open central corridor, red brick outer walls and the high perimeter wall around the park are protected by the National Board of Antiquities and remain as a reminder of the building's long and colorful history.

In early 2016, the hotel underwent a light refurbishment and an extensive interior decoration. The result is a modern design hotel with stylish décor and exceptional service, set in a historic prison atmosphere.

Suomenlinna, a UNESCO's World Heritage Site, is a fortress situated on a group of islands off Helsinki. Suomenlinna was built during the Swedish era as a maritime fortress and a base for the Archipelago Fleet. Work on the fortress begun in 1748.
